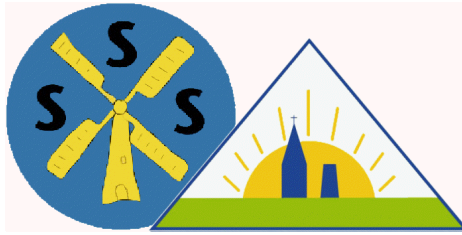

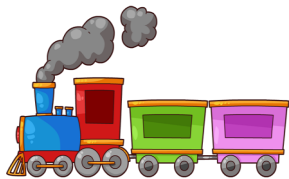


Shepeau Stow
